Regional Medical Assistance Team: a group of volunteer responders whose purpose is to stabilize, treat, and transfer, as appropriate, patients during a disaster or during a community-sponsored event such as air shows, marathons, and concerts. The team consists of trained /credentialed command staff, physicians, physician assistants, nurses, emergency medical technicians, paramedics, and administrative and logistics personnel. Mission types include set-up and operation of alternate care sites and responder rehabilitation.
